Please choose one:

_____ Band – The St. Mark's band performs at Episcopal School Sunday (October 14), Advent Lessons and Carols (December 6), Florida Bandmasters Association Music Assessment (Spring) and at the end of year concert (May 9). These performances are graded and required. Students in band are expected to practice regularly. To be in the advanced band, the student must have been playing their instrument for at least one year. Students are required to rent an instrument from either St. Mark's or a local music rental store if they do not own one. (5 days)

_____ Choir - The St. Mark's choir performs at Episcopal School Sunday (October 14), Advent Lessons and Carols (December 6), Florida Vocal Association Music Assessment (Spring) and at the end of year concert (May 9). These performances are graded and required. (5 days)

_____ Music Appreciation – In this course, students will learn about music history, orchestral instruments, composers, and how music affects our every day lives. Students will complete several projects throughout the year. Both classical and contemporary music will be incorporated into the course. (2 days).
